Sub: Restructuring of Gazetted Cadre of the Indian Railways – Upgradation of 11 IRSME posts from SA Grade to HA Grade (Rs.22400-24500), 42 posts from SG/JAG to SA Grade and 91 posts from Sr. Scale to JA Grade.

The gazetted cadre of Group`A` Railway Service (IRSME) has been reviewed and approved by the Government with a view to restructuring and strengthening the set-up to cope with the increased work load and responsibilities. The total sanction strength of IRSME Cadre would now include 25 posts in HA Grade (Rs.22400-24500) involving 11 upgradations from SA Grade, 139 posts in SA Grade (Rs.18400-22400) involving 42 upgradations from SG/JA Grade (including resultant effect of upgradation of higher grade posts) and 413 posts in JA Grade involving 91 upgradations from Sr.Scale (including resultant effect of upgradation of higher grade posts). Consequently, the number of Sr.Scale posts stand reduced from 383 to 257 on account of upgradation to higher grade and matching surrender.

- 2. Accordingly, sanction of the Ministry of Railways is hereby accorded to the upgradation of 11 IRSME posts from SA Grade to HA Grade (Rs.22400-24500), 42 posts from Selection Grade/JA Grade to SA Grade (including resultant effect of upgradation of higher grade posts) and 91 posts from Sr. Scale to JA Grade (including resultant effect of upgradation of higher grade posts) w.e.f. the date these posts are operated in the higher grade. Details of the posts to be upgraded are indicated in the **Annexure I** to this sanction.
- 3. The above posts which are permanent in the existing grade, shall be treated as permanent in the upgraded scale and if temporary, shall be treated as temporary in the upgraded scale. The dates of operation of the upgraded posts may please be intimated to this Ministry in due course.
- 4. Posting against the upgraded posts will be regulated by orders issued from this office.
- 5. The additional financial implication for the above upgradation, will be met by surrender of 35 regular Sr. Scale posts. The number of posts to be surrendered by each Railway have been indicated in **Annexure II** to this sanction. The Railway must ensure that these posts are surrendered simultaneously with the implementation of this sanction and this office advised accordingly. The surrender of posts should be finalized duly vetted by FA&CAO.

- 6. Wherever posts are provided by transfer from other Railways, the Railway may ensure that the posts are operated/upgraded after their release by the concerned Railway.
- 7. This issues with the concurrence of the Finance Directorate of the Ministry of Railways.
